New Business:

Action Item: DA Policy Proposal, Kristine Roshau, 1st Reading

- 1. The DA Policy proposal reflects regulations that the College will have to follow. A larger institutional plan is still being planned. This will impact all courses, not just distance education.
- 2. eLearning will provide a mix of tools and resources, web content, and trainings.
 - a. The eLearning website is in the process of becoming more centralized, including information on Universal Design for learning, teaching fundamentals, accessible course design, and access by design: creating in Canvas.
- 3. Faculty will need to work with eLearning to make these changes, but for the most part, only minor edits will likely need to be made.
- 4. Irregular wage and additional positions will need to be added in order to supplement this new influx of work.
- 5. If faculty don't use the gradebook in Canvas, they need to clearly specify in their syllabus that they aren't using the gradebook. Currently many different grading systems and software are in place, which creates some difficulty for eLearning.
- 6. It was proposed that this policy would be added to A-6-0 within the GPM, but this section already exists and seems dissimilar to the proposed information.

a. Could this be added to a new section? If a new section is required, it would need to be brought before College Affairs.
