

UNIVERSITY TRANSFER ADVISING



Second Language University Admissions Requirement: Students planning to transfer to a university who graduated from high school in 1997 or later must meet a foreign language requirement with either two years of high school level study in the same language or two quarters/semesters of college level study with a minimum grade of C- or better. Foreign language taken at an unaccredited high school does not qualify. For additional information on how to meet foreign language deficiencies view Oregon University System State Board of Higher Education [Second Language Admission Requirement](#).

Who must meet this requirement? The requirement applies to all students applying to a university that graduated from high school in or after 1997. Students that graduated from high school or completed a GED prior to 1997 are exempt from the second language requirement.

Are there exceptions? Yes, students can be admitted without the foreign language with an exception from the university, but will be required to complete two quarters or two semesters of a college-level second language prior to degree completion to make up the admission deficiency. Students seeking an exception must contact the Office of Admissions of the school they are seeking admission for more information.
