



## Option 1: Look up a specific occupation

Click on a Holland Type that is the best match for you.</p> <p>Occupations are listed by “Job Zone” from least to most amount of education.</p>	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>Realistic</b> Realistic occupations frequently involve work activities that include practical, hands-on problems and solutions. They often deal with plants, animals, and real-world materials like wood, tools, and machinery. Many of the occupations require working outside, and do not involve a lot of paperwork or working closely with others.</li><li><b>Investigative</b> Investigative occupations frequently involve working with ideas, and require an extensive amount of thinking. These occupations can involve searching for facts and figuring out problems mentally.</li><li><b>Artistic</b> Artistic occupations frequently involve working with forms, designs and patterns. They often require self-expression and the work can be done without following a clear set of rules.</li><li><b>Social</b> Social occupations frequently involve working with, communicating with, and teaching people. These occupations often involve helping or providing service to others.</li><li><b>Enterprising</b> Enterprising occupations frequently involve starting up and carrying out projects. These occupations can involve leading people and making many decisions. Sometimes they require risk taking and often deal with business.</li><li><b>Conventional</b> Conventional occupations frequently involve following set procedures and routines. These occupations can include working with data and details more than with ideas. Usually there is a clear line of authority to follow.</li></ul>
