CRFPD is located approx. 45 miles south of Bend on Hwy 97
Our fire district spans 13.4 square miles
and we provide Advanced Life Support (ALS) Ambulance Service
that covers 591 square miles serving approx. 2,000
residents year round. Our ambulance service includes the
communities of Crescent, Gilchrist, Crescent Lake and
Odell Lake Communities located on Highway 58,
Oregon Outback Fire District located on Highway 31 and the
South End of La Pine within the boundaries of Klamath County.
CRFPD also provides Mutual Aid and Automatic Aid on
Fire and Medical Incidents to our agency partners.



Program Overview:

You will be working directly alongside experienced and knowledgeable mentors learning the principles of firefighting, emergency medical services, rescue/extrication.



Program Requirements:

- Be enrolled at Central Oregon Community
 College in Fire Science or Paramedicine studies
- Applicants must be 18 years of age at the start of Fall Term
- Maintain appropriate cumulative GPA per district Resident Volunteer Guidelines
- Perform Fire, EMS, Station duties as appropriate to training level and Resident Volunteer Guidelines.
- Maintain 80% of nights per month residing at CRFPD Housing
- High School Diploma or Equivalent at Start of Fall Term
- Possess a Valid Driver's License with Insurable Driving Record by the District
