What is WR 121Z + Seminar?

WR 121Z + Seminar is a unique opportunity to take WR 121Z and a seminar companion course back to back. Students who qualify may register for one of the WR 121Z classes AND the companion course (WR 98: Seminar) that breaks down WR 121Z assignments in a supportive learning environment. Students must pass both classes (WR 121Z and WR 98) to pass WR 121Z.

Why is this a valuable opportunity? Students who would normally take WR 65 before taking WR 121Z or who miss placing into WR 121Z by a few points in the placement test's writing component would have the opportunity to start immediately in the WR 121Z along with WR 98, thus saving time and money.

How does it work? Interested students must complete the online Directed Self Placement questionnaire by sending an email to writingplacement@cocc.edu and respond to a faculty member's questions (and, if the faculty member deems it necessary, participate in a telephone or in-person interview). Students who are accepted into the program (WR 121Z + Seminar) will then be able to register for both WR121Z (4 credits) and WR98 (Seminar: 2 credits). Students must select one of the WR 121Z and WR 98 pairs, listed below.
